



SECTION VII: TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

DESCRIPTION OF MATERIAL-

The paper should be suitable for Offset and Laser printer by using MICR Ferromagnetic Toner or the paper should be attractive to electronic character recognition. Paper should be free from chemical residues like-arsenic, lead, copper, iron, reducible sulphur compounds, chlorides and sulphates, should be flattened, free from lint or dust, black holes, pinholes. The paper should be "Linen Finish" which is imparted to paper surface. Paper should enable to pass through the press under uniform pressure and without sheet distortion. Paper should be uniformity of distortion of fibers and grain direction of fibers should be always machine direction (according to length of sheet size). 




