Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

6. - (a) Average Annual turnover of the bidder firm should be more than Rs. 1,84,100/- during last three years i.e. 2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021.
- (b) Bidder firm should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three financial years i.e. 2018-2019,2019-2020 and 2020-2021.
- (c) The net worth of the firm should not be negative and should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three financial years i.e. 2018-2019,2019-2020 and 2020-2021.
- 3. The bidder should give a declaration that they have not been black-listed/ debarred for dealing by Government of India in the past.
