- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as pertine Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class II cocal suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 is seed

by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

# **Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions**

## 1. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

#### 2. Generic

For hazardous chemical/item, all precautionary measure as per regulation from the point of transportation/ handling/ storage/ safety/ health/ environment to be undertaken/ specified before dispatch. During dispatch, proper symbol for the hazard/ MSDS/ Batch No./ date of manufacturing/ Gross Weight/ Net Weight/ shelf Life etc are to be written/ printed/ pasted on the body of the packing.

#### 3. Generic

**Upload Manufacturer authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors are submitting the bid, Manufacturers Authorisation Form (MAF)/Certificate with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.

## 4. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Only supply of Goods

#### 5. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

# 6. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of General Manager Bank Note Press Dewas payable at Dewas.

Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.

## 7. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidders can also submit the EMD with Fixed Deposit Receipt made out or pledged in the name of A/C (Name of the Buyer). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of EMD, the FDR will be released in the favour of the bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Bidder has to upload scanned copy/ proof of the FDR along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date/ Bid Opening date

## 8. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidders can also submit the EMD with Banker's Cheque in favour of General Manager Bank Note Press Dewas payable at Dewas.

Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the BC along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.

## 9. Forms of EMD and PBG

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of General Manager Bank Note Press Dewas payable at Dewas. After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

## 10. Forms of EMD and PBG

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt so (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of General Manager Bank Note Press Dewas A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit

can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

- II. At the time of submitting the offer, bidder has to submit the following:-
- a. Sealed and Signed Technical Specification.
- b. Sealed and signed bid document as an acceptance of all additional terms and conditions, technical specification and payment terms as mentioned in the bid.
- III. The bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify:
- A. Experience & past performance: The Bidder should have Manufactured & Supplied "Pigment Carbon Black" of at least 3800 Kgs. In any one of the last five years ending on 31 st March 2021.
- **B. Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities**:-The Bidder must have an annual capacity to Manufacture & Supply at least 3800 Kgs "Pigment Carbon Black".

The bidder has to submit the following details along with the bid-

- (i) Name of the machine utilized to supply the quoted product.
- (ii) The number of machines being utilized for the production and the capacity of each machine.
- (iii) Total Annual capacity of Manufacturer.
- (iv) Supply orders in hand and proportionate capacity to supply quoted amount.

# C. Financial standing: -

(i)The Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder firm during last three years ending on 31 st March 2021 should be more than Rs.11,21,000/-

(ii)Bidder firm should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years ending on 31 st March 2021.

(iii) The net worth of the bidder firm should a. Not be negative on 31 st March 2021 and b. Not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31 st March 2021.

- III. 3rd Installment of 2400 KGs to be supplied within 90 days from the date of purchase order.
- IV. 4 th Installment of balance quantity to be supplied within 120 days from the date of purchase order.

### **New Supplier -**

**Pre- Production Sample**:- New supplier has to supply pre-production sample of "Pigment Carbon Black" in quantity of " 200 Kgs" within 15 days from the date of purchase order. The firm on whom supply order will be placed will have to supply the "Pigment Carbon Black" in 04 installments as mentioned below:

- I. 1st installment of 2400 KGs to be supplied within 30 days from the date of approval of preproduction sample.
- II. 2nd installment of 2400 KGsto be supplied within 60 days from the date of approval of preproduction sample.
- III. 3rd Installment of 2400 KGs to be supplied within 90 days from the date of approval of preproduction sample.
- IV. 4 th Installment of balance quantity to be supplied within 120 days from the date of approval of pre-production sample.

# **Disclaimer**

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid.
