SIT 1: Eligible Goods: All goods to be supplied under the contract shall have their origin in India or Indian Agent in case of imported item, subject to any restriction imposed in this regard in Section III (SIT). The term "origin" used in this clause means the place where the goods are mined, grown, produced, or manufactured or from where the related services are arranged and supplied.

SIT 2: Clarification of Tender Documents: A Tenderer requiring any clarification or elucidation on any issue of the tender documents may take up the same with BNP DEWAS in writing or by fax / e-mail/ post. SCC - 1: Packing and Marking:

The quality of packing, the manner of marking within & outside the packages and provision of accompanying documentation shall strictly comply with the requirements as provided in Technical Specifications and Quality Control Requirements under Sections VII and VIII and in SCC under Section V. In case the packing requirements are amended due to issue of any amendment to the contract, the same shall also be taken care of by the supplier accordingly.

SCC-8: Terms and Mode of Payment: The terms of payments would be as follows: 100% Payment will be made after Successful Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning & Acceptance of Band Testing Station by the Purchaser and on production of all required documents by the supplier on actual basis. The payment will be done through NEFT/RTGS Only. Therefore, the suppliers have to produce all the Bank details such as - Name of Bank, Account No., IFSC Code No., MICR No. along with the Tender Document.

SCC-9: Quantum of Liquidated damages: If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or fails to perform the services within the time frame(s) incorporated in the contract, BNP DEWAS shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to BNP DEWAS under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the ½% (0.5%) percent+ 18% GST (or any other percentage if prescribed in the SCC) of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/ or services for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% percent+ 18% GST (or any other percentage if prescribed in the SCC) of the delayed goods' or services' contract price(s). The Arbitrator so appointed shall be an SPMCIL Officer who had not dealt with matters to which this agreement relates and in course of his duties had not expressed views on all or any of the matter in dispute or differences. The Award of the Sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties.





SCC-12: Failure & Termination

A) Cancellation of contract for Default: Without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, like removal from the list of registered supplier, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, the contract may be terminated in whole or in part:

) If the supplier fails to provide any or all the goods within the time period (s) specified in the

contract, or any extension thereof granted

(ii) If the supplier fails to perform any other obligation under the contract within the period (s) specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted.

B) Termination of Contract for convenience: Bank Note Press, Dewas (M.P.) may at any time terminate the Contract by giving you one month's prior notice in writing to that effect and shall have the liberty to appoint any other agency to carry out your obligations under this Contract.

SCC-13: Force Majeure:

12.1 In the event of any unforeseen event directly interfering with the supply of stores arising during the currency of the contract, such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Contractor shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Unless otherwise directed by in writing, the supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the contract as far as reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.

If the force majeure condition(s) mentioned above be in force for a period of 90 days or more at any time, either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days' notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other, save and except those which had occurred under any other clause of this contract prior to such termination.

- 12.2 Notwithstanding the provisions contained in GCC clauses 23, 24 and 26, the supplier shall not be liable for imposition of any such sanction so long the delay and/ or failure of the supplier in fulfilling its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.
- 12.3 In case due to a Force Majeure event is unable to fulfill its contractual commitment and responsibility, BNP Dewas will notify the supplier accordingly and subsequent actions taken on similar lines described in above sub-paragraphs.



Function:-

The banding station is used to wrap a paper strip band on the 100 bank note Packets / 1000 note Bundles and installed on the cutpack machine and operate automatically when a bank note packet or bundle comes under this banding station. The banding cycle starts when a sensor triggers at particular timing slot. The machine is operated by pneumatic and servo motor controlled by PLC and servo drive. The paper band is in the form of roll with continuous glue on it. The band roll is mounted on the banding station and as per the packet/ bundle thickness the band size cut & sticked by heated sealing stamper.

Existing system:-

The whole banding system is consisting of two parts:-

- 1. Banding station:- it consists pneumatic cylinders, sensors, sealing/cutting unit, servo motor etc. it has one push button panel having 4 nos. of push buttons for band forward, band reverse, band cut and band seal. The compressed air required is 6 bars. The banding station is mounted on the Cutpack machine through guided sliding reels and easily detachable.
- 2. Control panel: It consists of 1. PLC make-ABB model-AC 500, 2. Servo drive make-Parker model-Compax3 and Opto-coupler. The control panel is mounted and fixed on the cutpack machine. The banding station and control panel is connected through wired I/O interface and communication via networking system Profi-bus. The control panel is also make communication with main control cabinet of

Cutpack machine through Arcnet & Profi-bus.

Requirement: - Stand-alone Testing unit.





Scope of work:-

Testing unit is required to test the Banding station separately offline the machine. Firm shall make the frame of testing unit so that bending station can be easily put and removed and the firm shall also make a control panel fixed on testing unit. The control panel should consist of PLC, servo drive, HMI and other components to set the parameters of temperature, sealing/cutting timing to operate the machine manually. All the software programs should be designed and loaded as per our requirement. The purpose of test unit / station is to make ready the defective banding station off line the cutpack machine. And whenever the banding station fails on the Cutpack machine the repaired one may be fixed immediately.

The machine is interfaced with controller and PLC through profibus having addresses of different locations. The Banding station have a push button control panel by itself, for (1) band feed forward (2) band feed reverse (3) band start (manual banding) (4) Band cutting.

These 4 buttons should be operable after installing on Test unit.

Terms & conditions:-

- 1. The firm shall visit BNP on any working day from 8 am to 5 pm with prior approval to understand the exact requirement before submitting the offer.
