The appellant filed an application dated May 08th, 2022 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (“RTI Act”) through the RTI MIS Portal bearing Registration No: IGMHY/R/E/22/00018. The respondent disposed of the request vide his online reply dated May 10th, 2022 to the appellant. The appellant filed the present appeal dated May 10th, 2022 against the above response. I have carefully considered the application, the response and the Appeal and find that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record. 2. From the Appeal, I note that the appellant is aggrieved by the respondent’s response to his application for providing incomplete information as far as S.No.4 is concerned. Queries in the application: 3. The following information was sought:1. What is present salary of Junior Office Assistant including all allowances , also provide the rate at which the allowances are admissible for the post. 2. Promotion policies for all non technical posts including Junior Office Assistant 3. At what rate perks are given to the employees of IGM Hyderabad, also provide the details policy documents regarding the same. 3. The respondent provided the information to the appellant well within the prescribed period of time as per the provisions contained in the RTI Act, 2005. 4. Grounds in Appeal – The applicant raised the appeal on the ground that, “Provided Incomplete, Misleading or False Information.” And stated as below: “Refer to my RTI application IGMHY/R/E/22/00018 The information provided by CPIO is incomplete. In sl no. 4 perks for every category of employee not given. Information regarding ONLY Jr office Assistant is given. Also policy documents regarding perks (for all category of employee) not given. 5. I note that the appellant had sought information with respect to the Promotion Policy of Jr.office Assistant & Perks of all categories of employees. Against this request CPIO(HR) vide his RTI reply dated 10.05.2022 has provided the following information: For S.No. 1 & 3 : Pay Scale for the post of Junior Office Assistant at B-3 level in the IDA Pay Scale: ₹.21,540 – ₹.77,160/- (3rd PRC) and other Allowances as applicable to B-3 Level. Perks @ 15%, HRA @ 27% as per the City Posted and Industrial DA @ 30% as applicable from time to time. For S.No.2: Please find attached herewith Page No. 4 of the SPMCIL Promotion Policy for office staff communicated vide Order No.CHO(HR)/Policy/27/24/2015/5906 dated 05.01.2016 containing relevant information as sought 6. In this regard, the undersigned had sought comments from the Respondent CPIO with whom the information is maintained with respect to the relief being sought by the Appellant. 7. Further, in response to the above direction of the undersigned, CPIO(HR) has provided the following comments on record: “...With reference to the appeal filed by the Appellant, it is to state that, the following are the present rates of Perks admissible to the IDA employees: 1) W1 to W-6 Grade(INDUSTRIAL WORKMEN CADRE), B-3 TO B-5 Grade (STAFF CADRE)@ 15%. 2) S1 TO S2 GRADE(SUPERVISORY CADRE), E1 TO E8 GRADE(EXECUTIVE/OFFICER CADRE) @ 35%. 3) POLICY DOCUMENT RELATING TO THE ABOVE CADRES ARE BEING UPLOADED ALONG WITH THESE COMMENTS.” 8. Accordingly the undersigned disposes of the present appeal as the relevant information has been provided by the CPIO which has been stated in Para 7. Further, <input type="button" value="Print"/> document relating to the aforesaid cadre is being uploaded along with this order. 9. In exercise of the powers,</p>

conferred upon the Appellate Authority under Section 19(6) of Right to Information Act, 2005, the appellate authority disposes of the appeal with the above information. 10. The Appeal stands disposed. The decision can be appealed against to CIC within a period of 90 days at below mentioned address or through the online RTI portal.
