There are four Note Printing Presses in India, amongst them two are governed by SPMCIL and two are subsidiaries of RBI:

- ❖ Currency Note Press, Nashik
- ❖ Bank Note Press, Dewas
- ❖ Bharatiya Reserve Bank Note Mudran Pvt. Ltd., Mysuru
- ❖ Bharatiya Reserve Bank Note Mudran Pvt. Ltd, Salboni

- **Who is the competent to issue notes/coins in India.**

Except one (1) rupee note/coin, RBI is the issuing authority for all notes. One rupee is maintained by Finance Secretary.
