

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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises vill be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 4. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as

defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Part Quantity Bidding

Buyer has allowed part quantity bidding, bidders can offer maximum quantity that they can deliver keeping in mind their capacity and delivery period requirements. The offer quantity has to be more than minimum bid quantity as specified by the Buyer in the bid. Offers with quantity less than Minimum are liable to be rejected. It may however be noted that there is no guarantee that full offer quantity will be ordered by the buyer. Quantity to be ordered by the buyer will depend on various factors including the Ranking of the bidder, Offered quantity, Splitting criteria indicated by the buyer in the bid and the requirement of the buyer to have multiple sources of supply for ensuring supply chain etc. Sellers would be notified about likely order quantity or range of possible order quantity at the time of price match request made by the buyer, ward of contract will be subject to acceptance of price match request along with min / max offer quantity as decided by the Buyer.

5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

i. Required Terms of Delivery:

For IBC (Intermediate Bulk Container): F.O.R. Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.) door delivery and unloading is in scope of SPM.

For Tanker: F.O.R. Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.) door delivery and unloading of the tanker is in scope of the supplier (Pump shall come with tanker).

- ii. Destination: Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (M.P.)-461005
- **iii. Preferred mode of Transportation:** Supplier to transport the contracted material/ supplies only through registered common carriers.
- iv. Standard sample of 100ml of manufactured qty. shall be carried along with tanker for each consignment along with test certificate issued by manufacturer.

v. Packing Standard:

The Containers shall bear legibly and indelibly the following information:

- vi. Payment Terms: 100% on receipt and acceptance (suitability) of goods by the SPM, Narmadapuram and on production of all required documents by the supplier.
- vii. Bidder Should Quote Prices Inclusive of GST And All Cost Components Such As Packing & Forwarding Details, Freight & Insurance Charges upto Destination etc. on FOR Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram (Madhya Pradesh), India.
- viii. Splitting may be done among maximum Two (02) Bidders in the ratio of 60:40 of the total bid quantity.

ix. QUALIFICATION/ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

i) Experience & Past Performance

The bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorised representative-hereinafter referred simply as 'The Bidder') should have manufactured and supplied Poly Amide Resin (PAR) of at least 4,00,000 KGs in any one of the last five years ending on 31st March 2021.

(Note: 'Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises' are exempted from 'Experience and Past Performance Criteria')

ii) Capability Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities

- a. The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 4,00,000 KGs Poly Amide Resin (PAR).
- b. The bidder has to submit the following details along with the bid:
 - i) Name of the machine utilized to supply the quoted product.
 - ii) The number of machines being utilized for the production and the capacity of each machine.
 - iii) Total Annual capacity of Manufacturer.
- iv) Supply orders in hand and proportionate capacity to supply quoted amount.

ii) Financial Standings:

a) The average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021, should be at least **Rs. 4,13,20,000.00** as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries.

{Note: 'Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises' are exempted from 'Average Annual Turnover Criteria'}

- b) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.
- c) i) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on 31.03.2021 and also
- ii) should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

Note:

- 1. All experience, past performance and capacity/capability related data should be certified by the authorized signatory of the bidder firm. The credentials regarding experience and past performance to the extent required as per eligibility criteria submitted by bidder may be verified from the parties for whom work has been done.
- All financial standings data should be certified by Certified Accountant's e.g. Chartered Accounts (CA) in India and Certified Public Accountants/Chartered Accountants of other countries.
- **3.** Bidder to furnish stipulated documents in support of fulfilment of qualifying criteria. Non-submission or incomplete submission of documents may lead to rejection of offer.
- **x.** If required SPM may visit the bidders works/factory during techno-commercial bid stage, to ascertain the bidder manufacturing capability & quality control methodology.
- xi. Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause: If the contractor fails to deliver the goods and/or services or any installment thereof within the Delivery Period, SPM Narmadapuram shall, without prejudice to other rights and remedies available to SPM, Narmadapuram under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as Liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the rate of 0.5 Percent of the delivered price of the delayed goods and/or services along with applicable GST of 18% on the LD amount for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery or performance, subject to a maximum deduction of the 10% (plus GST on the LD amount) of the delayed goods or services.
- **xii.** The terms and conditions, guidelines of SPMCIL Procurement Manual Version 2.0 will be applicable to this bid at any stage to avoid any conflict at later stage. xiii. SPM (as Buyer) is liable to deduct TDS u/s 194Q @ applicable rate on goods purchases (if applicable). In case of deduction of TDS under section 194Q; the Supplier (Vendor) need not to charge TCS u/s 206C (1H) on invoicing on or after 01.07.2021.

- **xiv.** Vendor has to submit declaration (refer Buyer added Specific ATC) in specified format for the compliance of Section 206AB of Income Tax Act, 1961. In case of non-submission of declaration; TDS will be deducted at higher rates (as applicable) as per section 206AB.
- **xv. GST Return**: Supplier should file the GST returns for outward supplies in time. In case of any Input Credit Loss to SPM by way of their failure to files GST Returns in time, SPM reserves the right to withhold the payment of further supplies till production of evidence of filling of Returns.

xvi. Manufacturer Authorization Certificate:

(a) If the bidder firm is manufacturer then firm has to submit the valid registration certificate.

(b) If the bidder firm is not the manufacturer then firm has to submit the valid manufacturer's authorization certificate/valid dealership certificate of the item supplied as per the standard form duly filled by OEM as per Annexure-XIV (refer Buyer added Specific ATC) of this tender document.

xvii. Bidder shall submit duly seal & signed copy of Section VII: Technical Specifications & Section VIII: Quality Control Requirements.

xix. WARRANTY CLAUSE:

19.1 The warranty shall remain valid for twelve months after the goods have been delivered to the final destination and accepted by SPM in terms of the contract or for fifteen months from the date of dispatch from the supplier's premises for domestic goods whichever is earlier.

19.2 In case of any claim arising out of this warranty, SPMCIL shall promptly notify the same in writing to the supplier.

19.3 Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed replace the defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost, at the ultimate destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/goods after providing their replacements and no claim, whatsoever shall lie on SPM for such replaced parts/ goods thereafter.

19.4 In the event of any rectification of a defect or replacement of any defective goods during the warranty period, the warranty for the rectified/ replaced goods shall be extended to a further period of twelve months from the date such rectified/replaced goods starts functioning to the satisfaction of SPM.

19.5 If the supplier, having been notified, fails to rectify/replace the defect(s) within a reasonable period SPM may proceed to take such remedial action(s) as deemed fit by SPM, at the risk and expense of the supplier and without prejudice to other contractual rights and remedies, which SPM may have against the supplier.

3. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

4. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

5. Generic

Upload Manufacturer authorization: Wherever Authorised Distributors are submitting the bid, Manufacturers Authorisation Form (MAF)/Certificate with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.

6. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or efter completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

7. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of Security Paper Mill payable at Narmadapuram.

Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.

8. Forms of EMD and PBG

Bidders can also submit the EMD with Fixed Deposit Receipt made out or pledged in the name of A/C

(Name of the Buyer). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of EMD, the FDR will be released in the favour of the bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of Security Paper Mill, Narmadapuram A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Also, GeM does not permit collection of Tender fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction as the case may be. Any stipulation by the Buyer seeking payment of Tender Fee / Auction fee through ATC clauses would be treated as null and void.

This Bid is also governed by the General Terms and Conditions

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
