9. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

#### 1. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

#### 2. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

#### 3. Generic

Experience Criteria: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for 3 years before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the year. In case of bunch bids, the primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

#### 4. Purchase Preference (Centre)

Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Micro and Small Enterprises whose credentials are validated online through Udyog Aadhaar for that product category. If the bidder wants to avail the reservation benefit, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service.

**5.2 Qualification and Eligibility Criteria:** The Bidder firm should meet following eligibility criteria to qualify in the Techno Commercial bid:

#### 5.2.1 Experience and past performance:

The bidder should have manufactured and supplied at least 400 Kg. of similar type of "Polythene Bags" in any one of the last five years ending on "'31 March 2021".

# *Note: The 'Experience and Past experience criteria' is exempted for Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises.*

5.2.2 Capability - Equipment & manufacturing Facilities: - The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 400 Kg. of "Polythene Bags". The bidder firm should submit undertaking regarding this requirement.

5.2.3 Financial Standing:

 The average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on '31.03.2021', should be at least Rs. 60,000/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India or equivalent in relevant countries.

**Note:** The 'Average Annual Turnover criteria' is exempted for Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises.

- ii) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years, ending on '31.03.2021'.
- iii) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on '31.03.2021' and also

iv) Should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on '31.03.2021'.

**5.3** Certificate of MSE: The firm must have a valid registration certificate as MSE issued by NSIC, DGS&D or any authorized body by Ministry of MSME for manufacturing of the tendered item and the same shall be submitted by the firm along with the tender/bid.
