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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be

given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

## Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

### 1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

#### **A. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION CRITERIA**

**1. Experience:** The bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorised representative) should have manufactured and supplied of at least 04 nos. of 12V, 200AH lead acid storage batteries in any one year during last five years ending on 31.03.2021 i.e. from 01st April 2016 to 31st March 2021.

*Note: Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.*

## 2. Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities:-

The Bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 04 nos. of 12V, 200AH lead acid storage batteries.

## 3. Financial Standing:

(i) Average Annual Turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021, should be at least Rs. 38,912/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the Financial Year 2018-2019, 2019-2020 & 2020-2021, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant.

*Note: The Average Annual Turnover criteria are exempted for Start-ups and Micro and Small Enterprises. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.*

(ii) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

(iii) The net worth of the bidder should not be negative and also not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

1. The firm shall enclose following documents along with the quotations:-

(a) The valid authorised dealership certificate in their own name issued by the original battery manufacturer.

(b) The product catalogue of the offered new batteries showing make, type, product code, ratings, capacities, dimensions, Image, weight, charging requirements etc.

(c) Offering of minimum 36 months guarantee (18F+18P) of the offered batteries and later on the Successful bidder will have to give Guarantee Certificate accordingly.

(d) Acceptance of one month delivery schedule to supply new batteries & to collect old batteries.

2. The separate rates should be quoted for each make & type of the batteries, if the offer is submitted for more than one make/type.

3. The Buyback is compulsory hence quotation must be submitted with mentioning of separate buyback rate. Accordingly, Scrap Sales Order will be placed. If required, firm may inspect the old batteries before quoting the buyback rate.

4. The lowest offer will be decided on the basis of Overall Cost i.e. Cost of new batteries (-) Buyback Amount of old batteries.

5. The incomplete offers non-fulfilling above requirements are liable to be reject and no further correspondence will be done with such bidder(s)

6. The new batteries will have to supply at ISP's Workshop Store/Power House and old batteries will have to be collected from Power House by the successful bidder.

7. The new batteries will be accepted only after successful trials & testing on the DG sets.

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### **C. Special Conditions of Contract (SCC)**

#### **(To be submitted on firm's Letter Head as a token of acceptance)**

**1) Transportation of Goods:** The transportation of goods to be procured will be done by the supplier on FOR ISP Basis. The total cost of the transportation should be indicated in the price bid of the item to be procured.

**2) Insurance:** Since Indigenous bidder has to deliver the material on FOR ISP Nashik basis therefore the cost of the insurance will also the part of the cost of the material borne by the supplier. A specific insurance cover for each consignment/supply is to be given by firm, as applicable.

**3) Distribution of Dispatch Documents for Clearance/Receipt of Goods:** The supplier shall send all the relevant dispatch documents well in time to ISP Nashik to enable ISP Nashik to clear or receive (as the case may be) the goods in terms of the contract.

**4) Guarantee Clause:** The bidder should offer minimum 36 months guarantee (18F+18P) of the offered batteries and later on the Successful bidder will have to give Guarantee Certificate accordingly.

**5) Taxes and Duties:** Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, fees, levies etc. incurred until delivery of the contracted goods to SPMCIL. If the tenderer fails to include taxes and duties as per law of the land in the tender, no claim thereof will be considered by purchaser at a later stage.

#### **NOTE:**

Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid.
