If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.
4. 5. Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1. Experience & Past Performance: The bidder should have experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending on 31st March 2021.

a. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 99,880/-.

or

b. Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 1,24,850/-.

or

c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 1,99,760/-.

In proof of having fully adhered to minimum eligibility criteria, attested copy of experience

certificate /Attested copy of Experience / Copy of Purchase Order issued by the parties to whom the similar type of works has been carried out should be submitted along with the bid.

Note: Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

2. Capability-Equipment & manufacturing Facilities:-

The bidder should be enlisted in either Central Public Works Department (CPWD) or Military Engineering Services (MES) or any other Government / PSU / Autonomous bodies.

3. Financial Standing:

(i) Average Annual Turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021, should be at least Rs. 99,880/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the Financial Year 2018-2019, 2019-2020 & 2020-2021, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant.

Note: The Average Annual Turnover criteria are exempted for Start-ups and Micro and Small Enterprises. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

(ii) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

(iii) The net worth of the bidder should not be negative and also not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

- 1) Raw materials, Tools & plants shall be arranged by the firm.

- 5) The payment will be made after successful completion of the work.
- 6) The firm shall abide by the safety & security norms of the organization.

- 10) Water & Electricity will be provided by ISP free of cost.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Also, GeM does not permit collection of Tender fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction as the case may be. Any stipulation by the Buyer seeking payment of Tender Fee / Auction fee through ATC clauses would be treated as null and void.

This Bid is governed by the [General Terms and Conditions](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
