In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid data sheet (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.
6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and

based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

7. 1. Service & Support

AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER: An office of the Service Provider must be located in the state of Consignee. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO BE SUBMITTED.

2. **Generic**

Actual delivery (and Installation & Commissioning (if covered in scope of supply)) is to be done at following address Currency Note Press Jail Road Nashik Road Nashik 422101.

3. **Certificates**

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

4. **Generic**

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

5. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

***Minimum Eligibility Criteria***

1. Experience and past performance:

The bidder should have experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending on 31.03.2021.

a. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 10,00,000.

or

b. Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 12,50,000.

or

c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 20,00,000.

2. Capacity and Capability Criteria:

The bidder should be enlisted in either Central Public Works Department (CPWD) or Military Engineering Services (MES) or any other Government/PSU/Autonomous bodies.

3. Financial Standing:

(a) Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder firm during last three years i.e., 2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 should be more than Rs. 10,00,000/-.

(b) Bidder firm should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three financial years i.e. 2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021.

(c) The net worth of the firm should not be negative and should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three financial years i.e. 2018-2019, 2019-2020 and 2020-2021.

4. The bidder should give a declaration on the letter head of the firm that they have not been black-listed/ debarred for dealing by Government of India in the past.

Note- i) In support of above clause no. (1) the bidders should strictly produce the copies of purchase orders, experience certificates, Job completion certificates of customer as a documentary evidence.

ii) In support of above clause no. (3) the bidders should strictly produce the copies of Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant Certified financial documents such as Profit and Loss statement, Balance Sheets for the last three financial years as mentioned above.

5. Duly Signed and Stamped Acceptance to Service Level Agreement uploaded by the Buyer.

6. Duly Signed and Stamped Acceptance to Scope of Work uploaded by the Buyer.

7. Duly Signed and Stamped Acceptance to Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions (All Clauses).

### ***Special Conditions for Rate Contract***

This Contract is of Annual Maintenance Nature and therefore, the work shall be executed when required. Hence, it may not be necessary that the full quantities of all the items will be exhausted. The prices quoted shall remain fixed and valid for 01 year from the date of contract.

#### **6. Generic**

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

#### **7. Forms of EMD and PBG**

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of Currency Note Press - A Unit of SPMCIL A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

## 8. Forms of EMD and PBG

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of Currency Note Press - A Unit of SPMCIL payable at Nashik. After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer in place of PBG within 15 days of award of contract.

## 10. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

## Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid.
