1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered

Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1. Experience: The bidder should have experience of having successfully completed similar kind of services for the value at least Rs. 1 Lakh, in any one of the last five years ending on 31st March 2021.

In proof of having fully adhered to minimum eligibility criteria, attested copy of experience certificate /Attested copy of Experience / Copy of Purchase Order issued by the parties to whom the similar type of services has been provided.

Note: Start-ups and Micro and small Enterprises are exempted from Experience and Past Performance criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

2. Capability:-

The bidder must have capability to provide the relevant services.

3. Financial Standing:

(i) Average Annual Turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021, should be at least Rs. 1 Lakh as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the Financial Year 2018-2019, 2019-2020 & 2020-2021, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant.

Note: The Average Annual Turnover criteria are exempted for Start-ups and Micro and Small Enterprises. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

(ii) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

(iii) The net worth of the bidder should not be negative and also not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on 31.03.2021.

(A) Scope of Work: -

1) Water proofing treatment over M.S. roof gutters and roof AC sheets cracks of ISP factory as per brief scope of work given below -

2) Quantity required = 260 R.mtr.

3) Width to be considered for application = 0.30 m.

(B) Work Process: -

1) Scraping & cleaning of the surface of affected portion of M.S. roof gutters, AC sheets etc.

2) Applying one coat of 'Superflex P-222'.

3) Then stick the 'fabric (cloth)' over it (width of fabric =0.30m).

4) After setting & proper sticking of fabric, apply one coat of 'Superflex P-222'

5) After drying and setting, apply one more coat of 'Superflex P-222' i.e. final coat of water proofing

treatment .

ANNEXURE - 'B'

Terms & Conditions: -

- 1) Raw material and tools & plants shall be arranged by the firm.
- 2) Working hours: - 08 am to 06 pm (Including lunch hour). Time may vary as per the need of the ISP.
- 3) Stipulated time of completion of the work: - To be started from date of issue of contract/purchase order to till 31st Oct. - 2022
- 4) The payment will be made after successful completion of the work.
- 5) Safety Precautions: - Being work of considerable height, proper safety precautions shall be adopted by the firm. The firm shall provide PP Safety equipments to their labour.
- 6) The firm shall abide by the safety & security norms of the organization.
- 7) Child labour will not be allowed.
- 8) If any accidents / injury / casualty happen, the sole responsibility will be of the firm. No compensation will be borne by ISP.
- 9) The firm shall provide the 'details viz. Bank branch name, A/c No., IFSC code, PAN card copy details' at the time of raising the bill.

3. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
